FEI SPORT SEMINAR



- The second Sports working Seminar took place in Caen, from the 1st to the 3rd October 2012, with the on-going collaboration of the Fédération Equestre Internationale.

The Sports Team of the Organizing Committee welcomed at the beginning of October, 8 people from the FEI, 4 Technical Delegates, appointed by the FEI as well as some representatives from the National Technical Direction of the French Equestrian Federation.

It was a great opportunity for the participants to visit, for the first time, the competition venues in Caen and/or Sartilly and le Haras du Pin. It also gave them the opportunity to validate a certain number of decisions, essential for the construction of this project, such as the detailed competition schedule, the sports areas (stables, arenas, etc) and the Sports Volunteers strategy. Finally, the calendar and format of the test events, scheduled in 2013 and 2014, have been finalized.

The horse welfare has also been discussed with the FEI Veterinary Director and will be at the heart of our concerns at all times.

The work will continue more specifically by discipline, in the upcoming months.
